Learning About People and Friends

During the Wobbler stage, children begin noticing and reacting to the people around them more intentionally. While infants primarily focus on caregivers, toddlers start observing other children and experimenting with early social interaction.

At our nursery in Mirdif, Dubai, toddlers spend time in small group environments where they can safely observe and interact with peers. Although true cooperative play has not fully developed yet, children often imitate each other's behavior, watch one another closely, and participate in shared activities.

Simple group experiences such as music time, circle activities, and guided play sessions help toddlers begin understanding social environments. They learn to wait briefly, observe others, and participate in group routines.

Imitation is one of the most powerful learning tools at this age. Toddlers frequently copy adult actions such as clapping, waving, stacking blocks, or pretending to talk on a toy phone. Educators use this natural tendency by modeling positive behaviors and encouraging gentle interaction between children.

Emotional development is also important during this stage. Toddlers begin expressing feelings more clearly, including excitement, frustration, curiosity, and affection. Caregivers respond calmly and consistently, helping children begin recognizing and managing their emotions.
